




GO WITH THE FLOW

The SW82 appears much larger than its length of 25m and beam of 5.9lm, due to the gradual tapering of the beam from the maximum point to the transom.

The SW82 is available in the Raised Saloon version with an airy under-deck open saloon, and a Flush Deck version, which features a sleek, stylish deck. There are also the choices between owner's cabin in the front or the back of the yacht, as well as a two, three or four guest cabin layout.








DOWN BELOW

The two-guest cabin layout on the other hand has the crew quarters in the front, and a much larger master suite in the back.


Guest cabins can be twin or double.






HULL CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

The hull is built on a female mould, using infusion technology and using epoxy resin.

Outer skin: Quadraxial glass and biaxial kevlarCore: core-cell 50mm, structural foam, vacuum bagged to obtain maximum bonding.

Inner skin: Woven roving $(0^{\circ}/90^{\circ})$, unidirectional (0°) and biaxial $(+45^{\circ}c/-45^{\circ})$ carbon.

DECK CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

The deck is built on a female mould.

Outer skin: woven roving $(0^{\circ}/90^{\circ})$, unidirectional (0°) and biaxial $(+45/-45^{\circ})$ carbon lamination using the infusion method.

Core: 20 mm structural foam, vacuum bagged to obtain maximum bonding.

Inner skin: woven roving $(0^{\circ}/90^{\circ})$ unidirectional (0°) and biaxial $(+45/-45^{\circ})$ carbon lamination using the infusion method.

Beam network between main bulkheads, carbon/e-glass or carbon construction, hollow premoulded sections where applicable.

The high stress areas such as the mast partners, upper rudder bearing and deck hardware are reinforced with unidirectional fibres. The coach roof will be built in the carbon fibre.
